We appreciate your interest in – and support of – our efforts to reduce the incidence and mortality rates of ovarian cancer by empowering all women, and those who love them, to recognize the subtle symptoms, assess their risk and seek proper medical attention for the best outcome.

Our BEAT the BIG O campaign reached more than 100,000 women last year. Our collaboration with medical professionals through our RULE OUT! Ovarian Cancer Early Detection Project is making serious progress toward earlier detection. We won't give up until the day when ovarian cancer screening is a routine part of every woman's annual gynecologic exam.

When detected in its early stages, there is a 92% chance for a cure. However, 85% of diagnoses are not made until the disease has progressed beyond the ovaries and the relative five-year survival rate is only 45%. There is a lot of room for improvement.
