

Summer has turned to fall, with all the changes that brings. Guests are beginning to ask for sweaters and jackets instead of T-shirts and shorts. In late August we distributed school supplies to dozens of children. The harvest of late-summer and fall crops continues in our Earthworks gardens—tomatoes, squash, potatoes.
